



2007 D'Adamo Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2007 D'Adamo Cabernet is an opaque ruby-purple color. The wine exhibits aromas of black cherry, huckleberry and mocha. The sweet ripe fruit coats the palate and is followed by layers of oak and vanilla. The tannins will continue to soften over the next several years.
