



2004 Buckeye Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes

The 2004 Buckeye wine is an intense opaque ruby purple color. There are heady aromas of ripe currant and plum intermixed with hints of mocha, violets and toasted oak. This concentrated wine coats the mouth with fine tannins and leaves a long lasting finish. Drink now or over the next 8 years.
